Directions to Naval Air Station Wildwood Aviation Museum 500 Forrestal Rd, Cape May, NJ 08204

From the North: Take the Garden State Parkway to Exit 4B/Rio Grande onto Route 47 North. At the third traffic light (Railroad Ave/Seashore Rd), make a left. At the next traffic light (Breakwater Rd), make a right. At the next light, (Shunpike/Langley Rd) make a right into the airport property. The sign at the entrance says Lower Township Public Safety Complex. Follow the road to the end, make a right, the museum and parking are on the left.

From the West or Northwest: Take Route 55 south. Route 55 becomes Route 47. Take Route 47 to Route 347 (just past the Maurice River Diner bear left). Route 347 merges back onto Route 47. Take Route 47 for approximately 15 miles to the traffic light at Railroad Ave. The Rio Grande Post Office will be on your right. Turn right onto Railroad Ave/Seashore Rd and follow directions above.

From Cape May or South: Follow signs for Route 9/109 and stay straight at jughandle to go onto Route 9 North. At the second traffic light after the jughandle, turn left onto Breakwater Rd and follow directions above.
